

Dear Fenwick Guest,

This letter is to inform you about what is expected of a guest of a Fenwick student. The Senior Prom will be held at The Hyatt Lodge in Oakbrook, IL on Saturday, May 18, 2019 from 6:00 to 11:00 p.m. Before purchasing a bid to the dance, your date signed a document outlining personal responsibilities to his/her guest, parents and to Fenwick. The document is summarized below.

Because we always strive to be at our best, our students may never be involved in the use, possession or under the influence of intoxicating beverages or drugs of any kind. Fenwick does not approve of pre-or-post dance parties that allow alcoholic beverages to be served. Please be aware, if you and/or your date come to the dance under the influence of an intoxicating beverage or drug of any kind you will NOT be allowed to attend the dance, bid money will NOT be refunded and you and your date will NOT be allowed to leave in that condition. Your date's parents will be called to transport you home. If it is determined that you or your date was under the influence, your date will be subject to disciplinary action by Fenwick.

PLEASE NOTE: Any student attending the dance may be subject to 'breathalyzer' testing. The testing will be conducted by a school administrator at specific intervals as students enter the dance. Testing will be conducted in a screening area where the test can be administered without the process being witnessed by other students. If a student tests positive, a second test will be administered. It will be conducted by another administrator using a different breathalyzer. If the student again tests positive, as stated, he/she will be denied entrance to the dance and their parent(s) will be immediately contacted. Any student who refuses to be tested will also be denied entrance to the dance and his/her parent(s) will be immediately contacted. It may be necessary during the dance to administer a breathalyzer test to a student whose demeanor may give reasonable suspicion that he/she may be under the influence of alcohol. The administration of the test will follow the same procedures identified above.

Dances sponsored by Fenwick require the Fenwick student's guest to be 19 years old or younger and to present a school ID at the door. Once you arrive at the dance, you and your date will not be allowed to leave until the dance is over.

APPROPRIATE ATTIRE AND BEHAVIOR ARE THE EXPECTATIONS OF THE EVENING. Dancing is to be safe and appropriate; sexually explicit dancing is not permitted. In the event that this occurs, you and your date will be asked to stop; if it reoccurs, you will be asked to leave the dance.

We want you and your date to have an enjoyable evening however, Fenwick students and their guests must always conduct themselves in a way that reflects our Catholic / Dominican Heritage.
