

## **Expendable Scholarship Funds**

These expendable Funds were established to provide immediate assistance and are intended to be fully spent over time. In some cases, annual fundraising efforts are undertaken to “replenish” these Funds on an on-going basis and in some cases the donor(s) who established the Fund(s) makes annual gifts to maintain the Fund(s). These Funds are not endowed and not necessarily expected to remain in perpetuity. Anyone can make a gift to any of these Funds to ensure that their purpose remains in place. Fenwick is extremely grateful to the donor(s) who established these Funds and those who regularly contribute to these Funds for their generous support of Fenwick.

A minimum commitment of \$50,000 is required to name an expendable fund.

### **Del Percio/Gassman Scholarship Fund**

*Originally established via gifts from the Del Percio/Gassmann Memorial Cancer Fund, this Fund was created to provide current tuition assistance to deserving Fenwick students from Elmwood Park.*

### **John Penicook Scholarship Fund**

*This Fund was established in loving memory of John Penicook and funded via generous gifts from his family. It was created to provide financial assistance to a Fenwick student who experiences unexpected, significant financial hardship during his/her senior year. **This fund is no longer active.***

### **Paul Raffaelli Scholarship Fund**

*This Fund was established by Karen (Raffaelli) Borsch in loving memory of her son and is annually funded via generous memorial gifts in Paul’s name. Paul coached football and was a beloved figure at Fenwick. The Fund provides current tuition assistance to one or more deserving Fenwick students.*

### **Anne Smedinghoff Memorial Scholarship Fund**

*Established in loving memory of Anne Smedinghoff '05 by her family and funded by her family and friends via memorial gifts made in her name, this Fund provides an annual scholarship to a Fenwick rising senior with particular interest in international relations and/or government service.*

### **Spingola Family Scholarship Fund**

*Funded via gifts and established by the extended Spingola family, for the late Joseph P. Spingola '41, Richard Spingola '54, Robert Spingola '54 and for Janet Spingola Dovidio (FHS teacher, 1971-72), this Fund provides an annual \$1,000 scholarship to a high achieving, rising FHS senior student.*

### **John Crowder Scholarship Fund**

*Established in loving memory by several family members, classmates and friends of John J. Crowder '81 in gratitude for what Fenwick High School meant to John, his family and friends, this Fund is funded via annual gifts from a separate 501(c)3 organization supported by John’s friends and family. This Fund was created to provide one or more annual tuition assistance scholarships to students.*

### **John Malone "JM 52" Scholarship Fund**

*Established in loving memory by the parents of John J. Malone '11 in gratitude for what Fenwick High School meant to John, this Fund is funded via annual gifts from a separate 501(c)3 organization supported by John’s friends and family. “52” was John’s basketball jersey number and is a reminder of John’s continuing presence at Fenwick. This Fund was created to provide one or more annual tuition assistance scholarships to students.*

**Don Heldmann Memorial Fund**

*Established via memorial gifts in memory of Don Heldmann, former Fenwick faculty member and football coach, this Fund was established to provide a scholarship to the son or daughter of a police officer or firefighter. **This fund is no longer active.***

**Class of '52 Scholarship Fund**

*Originally funded via an anonymous gift from a member of the Fenwick class of 1952, this Fund was created to provide the equivalent of one annual full tuition scholarship to one or more deserving Fenwick students. In appreciation and gratitude for all that Fenwick has done for them, many members of the class of '52 have since contributed to this Fund.*

**Pat and Linda O'Brien Scholarship Fund**

*Originally funded via a generous gift from Pat '59 and Linda O'Brien, this Fund was established in appreciation for and recognition of the significant positive impact Fenwick had on the Donors. This Fund was established to provide current tuition assistance to deserving Fenwick students.*

**George E. Tapling '73 Memorial Scholarship Fund**

*This Fund was established by several members of the Class of '73 in memory of their friend and classmate George Tapling. This Fund was created to provide current tuition assistance to St. Giles School alumni who matriculate to Fenwick. Many members of the Class of '73 and other friends and family of George have since contributed to the Fund.*

**Class of 1996 Scholarship Fund**

*Established and originally funded by an anonymous member of the class of 1996 in gratitude for what Fenwick High School has meant to him and his classmates, this Fund was created to provide the equivalent of a full tuition scholarship to one or more Fenwick students for a period of years.*

**Ritchie Family Scholarship Fund**

*This Fund was established by Meredith and Bill Ritchie '79 in honor of Meredith's mother, Cecile "Susie" Tiller, who firmly believed in the value of education to further women's passions. This Fund annually provides a \$2,500 scholarship to a female Fenwick student who plans to matriculate to a four-year college or university.*

**Ida May Muller Scholarship**

*This Fund was created and is currently being funded by Len Muller '56 in loving memory of his mother Ida May Muller in appreciation for her support and ensuring that Len could attend Fenwick High School. This Fund provides at least two annual \$5,000 scholarship awards to incoming Fenwick freshmen who graduated from St. Mary's of Riverside elementary school.*
