

Dear Fenwick Parent,

This letter is to inform you that your son/daughter intends to purchase a bid to the Turnabout Dance which will be held at Fenwick High School in the Fieldhouse Gym from 7:30–10:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 23<sup>rd</sup>. Students may purchase a single bid for themselves if they will be unescorted, or a couple's bid if being escorted by another student. A student and parent signature must appear on this document in order for a bid to be purchased. The signatures confirm that you are aware of your son/daughter's responsibilities to his/her guest, to you, and to Fenwick.

Fenwick does not approve of pre-or-post dance parties that allow alcoholic beverages to be served. Please be aware, if you and/or your date come to the dance under the influence of an intoxicating beverage or drug of any kind you will NOT be allowed to attend the dance, bid money will NOT be refunded and you and your date will NOT be allowed to leave in that condition. Authorities may be contacted in some cases. Parents of all involved parties will be contacted in all cases.

PLEASE NOTE: Any student attending the dance may be subject to 'breathalyzer' testing. The testing will be conducted by a school administrator at specific intervals as students enter the dance. Testing will be conducted in a screening area where the test can be administered without the process being witnessed by other students. If a student tests positive, a second test will be administered. It will be conducted by another administrator using a different breathalyzer. If the student again tests positive, as stated, he/she will be denied entrance to the dance and their parent(s) will be immediately contacted. Any student who refuses to be tested will also be denied entrance to the dance and his/her parent(s) will be immediately contacted. It may be necessary during the dance to administer a breathalyzer test to a student whose demeanor may give reasonable suspicion that he/she may be under the influence of alcohol. The administration of the test will follow the same procedures identified above.

The Turnabout Dance sponsored by Fenwick requires that all attendees be Fenwick students, except for the senior class. Seniors are allowed to bring guests from other schools. **All attendees must present a school ID at the door.** All students attending are expected to follow all Fenwick rules while traveling to, attending, and leaving the dance.

- APPROPRIATE ATTIRE AND BEHAVIOR ARE THE EXPECTATIONS OF THE EVENING. Appropriate dress for turnabout must follow the listed expectations on pg. 45 of the Parent-Student Handbook under School Dances. Students not following these guidelines will not be allowed to enter the dance and further disciplinary action may be brought. Dancing is to be safe (no moshing or other types of dances that could cause harm which includes but is not limited to, "bodysurfing", "slam-dancing", "grinding", "Over-sexualized" or any style of dancing deemed inappropriate by the dance supervisors. If too many couples are dancing inappropriately, the lights will be turned on and/or the music changed as a collective warning for everyone.
- All students will receive a wristband upon entrance to the dance. If an administrator or chaperone observes any of the listed behaviors, he/she will cut off the wristband. If the student continues to dance in that fashion, a parent will be called and the student will be removed from the dance. The student will also be banned from their next dance.

We want you and your date to have an enjoyable evening however, Fenwick students and their guests must always conduct themselves in a way that reflects our Catholic / Dominican Heritage.
