

Self-Administration of Asthma Medication Permission Form

Policy statement for Fenwick High School:

Dear Parent/Guardian,

State Law requires we inform the parents/guardian(s) of the student, in writing, that the school and its employees and agents shall incur no liability as a result of any injury arising from self-administration of asthma medication by the student.

The permission for self-administered asthma medication is effective for the school year for which it is granted and must be renewed each school year. A student with asthma may possess and use his/her medication while in school, at school-sponsored activities, while under the supervision of school personnel, and/or before or after regular school activities. We recommend that you provide an additional dose of medication to be kept at school in the event that your child forgets or loses the medication.
